New South Wales

An Act to repeal the *Constitutional Powers (New South Wales) Act 1978* and to annul the *Privy Council Appeals Abolition Bill 1979*.

1 Name of Act

This Act may be cited as the *Constitutional Legislation (Repeal) Act 1985*.

2 Repeal of Act No 130, 1978

The *Constitutional Powers (New South Wales) Act 1978* is repealed.

3 Annulment of Privy Council Appeals Abolition Bill 1979

The passage of the *Privy Council Appeals Abolition Bill 1979* through the Legislative Assembly and the Legislative Council of New South Wales during the forty-sixth Parliament is annulled and the Bill has no force or effect.
