Anti-Discrimination Amendment (Equal Opportunity in Public Employment) Act 2007 No 79



An Act to amend the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* with respect to separate annual reporting on EEO matters and to update references to persons with a disability.

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Anti-Discrimination Amendment (Equal Opportunity in Public Employment) Act 2007.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.

3 Amendment of Anti-Discrimination Act 1977 No 48

The Anti-Discrimination Act 1977 is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

4 Repeal of Act

- (1) This Act is repealed on the day following the day on which this Act commences.
- (2) The repeal of this Act does not, because of the operation of section 30 of the *Interpretation Act 1987*, affect any amendment made by this Act.

[1] Section 122C Objects

Omit "physical impairment" from section 122C (a). Insert instead "disability".

[2] Sections 122C (b) and 122I (3)

Omit "physically handicapped persons" wherever occurring.

Insert instead "persons who have a disability".
