## Racing Administration Amendment Act 1999 No 17



An Act to amend the *Racing Administration Act 1998* to enable prescribed persons and bodies to publish certain betting information relating to interstate totalizator operations; and for other purposes.

### 1 Name of Act

This Act is the Racing Administration Amendment Act 1999.

### 2 Commencement

This Act commences on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation.

### 3 Amendment of Racing Administration Act 1998 No 114

The *Racing Administration Act* 1998 is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

### **Schedule 1 Amendments**

(Section 3)

### [1] Section 28 Publication or advertising of certain dividends or betting odds not affected

Insert at the end of the section:

(2) Nothing in this Part prohibits or restricts the publication, by a person or body prescribed by the regulations, of information relating to the dividends or betting odds, or probable dividends or betting odds, payable in respect of a totalizator operation conducted in another State or Territory by a person or body authorised under the law of that other State or Territory to conduct totalizator operations.

### [2] Section 37 Regulations

Insert at the end of the section:

(2) A regulation may apply, adopt or incorporate the provisions of any code or other

publication, with or without modifications, either as in force as at a particular day or as in force for the time being.
