Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Amendment Act 2002 No 95



An Act to amend the *Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Act 1998* to enable the Australian Taxation Office to be prescribed as an authorised agency for the purposes of the Act.

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Amendment Act 2002.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent.

3 Amendment of Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Act 1998 No 154

The Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Act 1998 is amended by inserting after paragraph (e) (v) of the definition of **authorised agency** in section 3:

(vi) the Australian Taxation Office.
