1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the [Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2011](#).

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 September 2011 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

Note—

This Regulation replaces the [Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2004](#) which is repealed on 1 September 2011 by section 10 (2) of the [Subordinate Legislation Act 1989](#).

3 Definition

(1) In this Regulation:

the Act means the [Unlawful Gambling Act 1998](#).

(2) Notes included in this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

4 Penalty notice offences

(1) For the purposes of section 52 of the Act:

(a) each offence created by a provision specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 is a prescribed offence, and

(b) the prescribed penalty for such an offence is the amount specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1.

(2) For the purposes of the definition of **authorised officer** in section 52 (9) of the Act, police officers are prescribed in relation to all offences specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1.

5 Savings

Any act, matter or thing that, immediately before the repeal of the *Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2004*, had effect under that Regulation continues to have effect under this Regulation.
