1 Name of Order

This Order is the Contract Cleaning Industry (Portable Long Service Leave Scheme) (Levy Determinations) Order 2011.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on 1 July 2011 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definition

In this Order:

the Act means the Contract Cleaning Industry (Portable Long Service Leave Scheme) Act 2010.

4 Determination of levy-employees

For the purposes of section 48 (1) of the Act, 1.7 percent of an employee's ordinary remuneration is determined.

5 Determination of levy—contractors

For the purposes of section 49 (1) of the Act, 1.7 percent of a contractor's ordinary remuneration is determined.
