# **Education Amendment Act 2008 No 12**



An Act to amend the *Education Act 1990* with respect to overseas students and admission to government schools; and for other purposes.

#### 1 Name of Act

This Act is the Education Amendment Act 2008.

#### 2 Commencement

- (1) This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act, except as provided by subsection (2).
- (2) Schedule 1 [3] commences on the date of assent to this Act or on the commencement of section 26C of the *Education Act 1990* (as inserted by Schedule 1 [5] to the *Education Legislation Amendment Act 2006*), whichever is the later.

### 3 Amendment of Education Act 1990 No 8

The Education Act 1990 is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

## 4 Repeal of Act

- (1) This Act is repealed on the day following the day on which all of the provisions of this Act have commenced.
- (2) The repeal of this Act does not, because of the operation of section 30 of the *Interpretation Act 1987*, affect any amendment made by this Act.
