1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Energy Services Corporations (Country Energy) Regulation 2001.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 June 2001.

3 Variation of name

Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the *Energy Services Corporations Act 1995* is amended by omitting the name "NorthPower" and by inserting instead the name "Country Energy".

Note-

On the day on which this Regulation takes effect, Schedule 5 to the *State Owned Corporations Act 1989* will, pursuant to section 20B (1A) of that Act, be amended to reflect the change of name effected by this clause.
