Senators' Elections Amendment Act 2007 No 1

Act No 1, 2007

An Act to amend the *Senators' Elections Act 1903* with respect to the close of the electoral rolls. [Assented to 6 June 2007]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Senators' Elections Amendment Act 2007.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.

3 Amendment of Senators' Elections Act 1903 No 9

The Senators' Elections Act 1903 is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

4 Repeal of Act

- (1) This Act is repealed on the day following the day on which this Act commences.
- (2) The repeal of this Act does not, because of the operation of section 30 of the *Interpretation Act 1987*, affect any amendment made by this Act.
