Citation

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Children (Care and Protection—Review of Child Deaths) Regulation 1996.

Commencement

2. This Regulation commences on 1 June 1996.

Prescribed date relating to register of child deaths

3. For the purposes of section 103 (1) (a) (ii) of the Children (Care and Protection) Act 1987, the prescribed date is 1 January 1996.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Under section 103 (1) (a) (ii) of the Children (Care and Protection) Act 1987, the Child Death Review Team has the function of maintaining a register of child deaths occurring in New South Wales after a date prescribed by the Regulations. The object of this Regulation is to prescribe 1 January 1996 as the date for the purposes of that section.

This Regulation is made under the Children (Care and Protection) Act 1987, including section 103 (1) (a) (ii) and section 124 (the general regulation making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters of a machinery nature.
