His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Children (Interstate Transfer of Offenders) Act 1988*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal and remake, with no changes in substance, the provisions of the *Children (Interstate Transfer of Offenders) Regulation 1995*. The Regulation declares other States and Territories that have enacted legislation dealing with the interstate transfer of young offenders. This enables the Minister to enter into agreements with those States and Territories for the transfer of young offenders between those State and Territories and New South Wales.

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters arising under legislation that is substantially uniform or complementary with legislation of another State or Territory.

This Regulation is made under the *Children (Interstate Transfer of Offenders) Act 1988*, including section 22 (the general power to make regulations) and section 4.

This Regulation is made in connection with the staged repeal of statutory rules under Part 3 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

Clause 1 Children (Interstate Transfer of Offenders) Regulation 2000

Children (Interstate Transfer of Offenders) Regulation 2000

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Children (Interstate Transfer of Offenders) Regulation 2000*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 March 2000.

3 Definition

(1) In this Regulation:

the Act means the *Children (Interstate Transfer of Offenders) Act 1988*.

(2) The explanatory note does not form part of this Regulation.

4 Legislation of other States and Territories

For the purposes of section 4 (2) of the Act, the following States and Territories are declared to have enacted legislation dealing with the interstate transfer of young offenders:

South Australia

Tasmania

5 Repeal

The *Children (Interstate Transfer of Offenders) Regulation 1995* is repealed.
