Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Unlawful Gambling Act 1998*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to remake, with some changes, the provisions of the *Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2004* which is repealed on 1 September 2011 by section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

This Regulation prescribes police officers as persons who may issue penalty notices under the *Unlawful Gambling Act 1998*.

This Regulation also makes provision with respect to the following:

- (a) the offences under that Act that may be dealt with by way of penalty notices,
- (b) the levels of penalties payable under those penalty notices,
- (c) savings and formal matters.

This Regulation is made under the *Unlawful Gambling Act 1998*, including sections 52 and 57 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely matters of a machinery nature and matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on any sector of the public.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2011*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 September 2011 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

Note. This Regulation replaces the *Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2004* which is repealed on 1 September 2011 by section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

3 Definition

- (1) In this Regulation:
 - the Act means the Unlawful Gambling Act 1998.
- (2) Notes included in this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

4 Penalty notice offences

- (1) For the purposes of section 52 of the Act:
 - (a) each offence created by a provision specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 is a prescribed offence, and
 - (b) the prescribed penalty for such an offence is the amount specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1.
- (2) For the purposes of the definition of *authorised officer* in section 52 (9) of the Act, police officers are prescribed in relation to all offences specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1.

5 Savings

Any act, matter or thing that, immediately before the repeal of the *Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2004*, had effect under that Regulation continues to have effect under this Regulation.
